Thank you to all those others who lent hands, large and small, throughout this process including: Dan Carter, Jose Felix, Haley, Daniela, Sofia, Melina, Amelia, food pantry volunteers...It has truly taken a community to make this real.

But we still have this question; what are we going to do with ourselves now? Now we dream. As we settle into the reality of letting go of the fiscal, physical, and time burdens of maintaining property, we can put all those gifts to work in ministry of a new sort. ## Stewardship Council Report

The closing on the sale of the church property to New Life took place on May 27, 2021. As of that date, New Life Bible Chapel became the owner of our property, including the church building and parsonage, and CCVP became a space sharing partner pursuant to a written Space Sharing Agreement between New Life and our church. The Space Sharing Agreement specifies the terms under which we can use the building and specifies the areas in which we will carry out our ministry. We will need to work to remember that we are now guests and not owners of the property.

We are fortunate that New Life supports the continuing work of the Disciples Food Pantry which will operate in a slightly re-configured space. We will be able to continue to operate from the same church office and the pastor's office. Thanks to the help of many people the west end of fellowship hall has been transformed to a dedicated worship space for our Sunday morning worship and other gatherings.

Much work had to be done over the last several months to prepare for the sale, including cleaning out, making decisions about what property inside the building should be retained by CCVP, what should be offered to New Life, and arranging for disposal or removal of the rest of the items. More work was done to design the new worship space, make necessary purchases and install new carpeting, furniture, and equipment.

Going forward, we will need to make adjustments in how things were done in the past as we are now space sharing partners instead of building owners. However, we will also be free of the responsibilities of building ownership and open to God's call for us for doing ministry in new ways in the future.

*Personal note from Doris Carter:* Thank you to the Stewardship Council members Chuck Bohl, Joan Fuller, Heidi Gomez, John Martin, Betty Prorak, and Josh Reed and to Pastor Laura who took on weighty responsibilities, sought out God's call for our church, and worked tirelessly for many months to get our church to this point.
