**Guidelines for CCVP Ministries
Updated March 2022**

The building is open for in-person worship on Sunday mornings and CCVP is holding in-person worship in its new worship space following the guidelines below. However, online worship will continue with the worship service being available live on Facebook Live.

New Life Bible Chapel, the building owner, may establish any guidelines relating to the building in general that it chooses. Please be mindful of any signs or directives from New Life as you enter the building. They have advised that they are following current state and federal guidelines.

For those individuals attending in-person worship with CCVP or in the building for meetings or ministry activities, please respect and follow these guidelines until further notice:

- Masks are optional for those attending worship or engaging in any other ministry work associated with CCVP
- Stay home if you are not feeling well or have a fever over 100 degrees.
- Stay home if you have been exposed to COVID-19 or have tested positive for COVID-19.
- Wash hands and/or use hand sanitizer as needed.
- Immediately notify the church if you have joined us for worship and subsequently test positive for COVID-19 and advise the dates and times you were in the building recently.

Small group church meetings (i.e., Stewardship Council, Elders, Worship Committee) may happen electronically via Zoom or telephone conference, or in-person with the consensus of those involved.

The Disciples Food Pantry currently continues to operate as a drive through pantry but is considering return to client pick up in the building with modifications.
